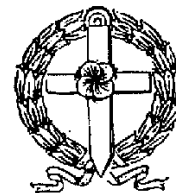

The day the guns fell silent

World War 1 November

11th - Armistice Day The Armistice is signed at 5.00am and comes into effect at 11.00am. At 10.57am Canadian Private George Lawrence Price is killed while on patrol in Canal du Centre. He is the last soldier to die in action on the Western front.

13th - Death recorded on this day a century ago and named on our memorial:

Second Lieutenant James Mayall

14th - General Von Lettow-Vorbeck surrenders his East African forces on the Chambezi River, Northern Rhodesia.
