## Short thought

One of my favourite activities when it comes to the feast of Christ the King was to ask children what a king looks like. Many will describe regal robes, large crowns, lots of gems and coins. Some will show how Kings strut around drunk with power ordering people to do this and that. In the Gospel we see that Pilate is obsessed with Jesus being a king, being someone who could take away the power that Pilate wants to have. Yet Jesus is not anything like the human vision of a king. Jesus' kingship is one of truth – the truth of God's love and longing for humanity to be one with God. Jesus' enthronement involves a coronation of a crown of thorns, his clothes stripped away, and a terrible death. Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life, so this is the King we welcome into our hearts, His words as truth, His life as truth, His love as truth. Christ the King that humanity's mind cannot understand - until we let Him into our lives.
